**ORDER GRANTING THE RECEIVER'S UNOPPOSED EXPEDITED
MOTION TO LIFT THE LITIGATION INJUNCTION TO AUTHORIZE
RECEIVER TO ENTER INTO MEDIATED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH
CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE FOR CAH ACQUISITION COMPANY 12, LLC, ET AL.**

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon the Receiver's Motion to Lift the Litigation Injunction to Authorize Receiver to Enter into Mediated Settlement Agreement with Chapter 11 Trustee for CAH Acquisition Company 12, LLC, *et al.* [ECF No. 320] ("Motion"), filed on October 14, 2020. In the Motion, the Receiver seeks to modify the Court's Amended Order Appointing Receiver dated August 13, 2020 [ECF No. 141], so as to lift the litigation injunction provided for in that Order to permit the Receiver to enter into a settlement agreement in order to resolve portions of a bankruptcy claim and to avoid a costly bankruptcy adversary proceeding.

The Receiver has made a sufficient and proper showing in support of the relief requested. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Receiver's Unopposed Expedited Motion to Lift the Litigation Injunction to Authorize Receiver to Enter into Mediated Settlement Agreement with Chapter 11 Trustee for CAH Acquisition Company 12, LLC, *et al.* [ECF No. 320] is **GRANTED**.

The litigation injunction set forth in the Court's Amended Order Appointing Receiver dated August 13, 2020 [ECF No. 141] is hereby lifted to Authorize Receiver to Enter into Mediated Settlement Agreement with Chapter 11 Trustee for CAH Acquisition Company 12, LLC, *et al.*
