CLARIFICATION OF ORDER [ECF NO. 202] AND REQUEST FOR HEARING**

**THIS CAUSE** comes before the Court on Non-Party Broadway Advance, LLC's ("Broadway") Motion for a Clarification of Order [ECF No. 202] and Request for Hearing [ECF No. 251] ("Motion"), and Broadway's Report of Discussions with Receiver [ECF No. 341] ("Report"). In the Report, Broadway indicates that it has conferred with the Receiver and that the Receiver does not oppose the release of the funds held by Actum Processing for Broadway. *See* Report at 1. Having reviewed the Motion, the Receiver's and Plaintiff's responses [ECF Nos. 263 and 266], the declarations submitted by Broadway [ECF Nos. 281 and 302], and the Report, and being otherwise fully advised, it is hereby

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the funds held by Actum Processing for Broadway Advance, LLC shall not be frozen pursuant to the Court's Order Granting Preliminary Injunction by Consent as to Defendant Joseph Cole Barleta [ECF No. 202] or any of the other Orders entered by the Court to date in this action.
