**ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION TO STAY CASE  
AS TO DEFENDANT JOHN GISSAS**

**THIS CAUSE** comes before the Court upon Plaintiff's Agreed Motion to Stay this Case as to Defendant John Gissas [ECF No. 348] ("Motion"), filed on October 26, 2020. The Motion indicates that Plaintiff and Defendant Gissas have reached a tentative settlement and require time to finalize the settlement papers and obtain authorization from the Commissioners of the Securities and Exchange Commission. Accordingly, Plaintiff seeks a 90-day stay of this case as to Defendant Gissas. The Court having reviewed the Motion and being otherwise fully advised, it is hereby

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Motion [ECF No. 348] is **GRANTED**. This case is hereby stayed as to Defendant Gissas for **ninety (90) days**.
2. On or before **January 25, 2020**, Plaintiff shall file a stipulation of dismissal regarding the claims against Defendant Gissas or a report regarding the status of its efforts to finalize the settlement with Defendant Gissas.
