ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION TO STAY CASE AS TO DEFENDANT JOHN GISSAS

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon Plaintiff's Agreed Motion to Stay this Case as to Defendant John Gissas [ECF No. 348] ("Motion"), filed on October 26, 2020.
