Ryan K. Stumphauzer, Esq., Court-Appointed Receiver ("Receiver") of the Receivership Entities, 1 by and through undersigned counsel, hereby files this files this Status Report regarding [ECF No. 365] the Court's Order Granting Motion to Stay Case as to the Receivership Entities that are Defendants, and states:

1. Several of the Receivership Entities—namely Complete Business Solutions Group, Inc. d/b/a Par Funding; Full Spectrum Processing, Inc.; ABetterFinancialPlan.com LLC d/b/a A Better Financial Plan; ABFP Management Company, LLC f/k/a Pillar Life Settlement

Management Company, LLC; ABFP Income Fund, LLC; ABFP Income Fund 2, L.P.; United Fidelis Group Corp.; Fidelis Financial Planning LLC; Retirement Evolution Group, LLC;, RE Income Fund LLC; and RE Income Fund 2 LLC—are Defendants in this action (the "Receivership Entity Defendants").

- 2. On November 2, 2020, the Court granted the Receiver's Motion to Stay Case as to the Receivership Entity Defendants. (ECF No. 365). In that Order, the Court indicated that "[o]n or before November 9, 2020, the Securities and Exchange Commission and the Receiver shall finalize and submit the proposed consent judgment the Receiver intends to enter into on behalf of the Receivership Entity Defendants or, alternatively, the Receiver shall file a report regarding the status of his efforts to finalize the consent judgment." (Id., ¶ 2).
- 3. The Receivership Entity Defendants have now agreed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on the form of a stipulated Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief Against the Corporate Defendants (the "Proposed Judgment"). Accordingly, the Receiver anticipates that the Securities and Exchange Commission will file a motion in the near future requesting entry of the Proposed Judgment.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver respectfully submits this status report regarding the Court's Order Granting Motion to Stay Case as to the Receivership Entities that are Defendants.
