**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S MOTION TO APPROVE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN  
ELECTRONIC DISCOVERY COSTS IN THE ORDINARY COURSE OF THE  
ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION OF THE RECEIVERSHIP**

**THIS CAUSE** comes before the Court upon the Receiver's Motion to Approve Payment of Certain Electronic Discovery Costs in the Ordinary Course of the Administration and Operation of the Receivership [ECF No. 470] ("Motion"), filed on January 15, 2021. In the Motion, the Receiver seeks the Court's approval of: (1) the Receiver's utilization of IST Management Services, Inc. ("IST") to process certain electronic data and host it on a review platform in order to manage and review it efficiently; and (2) the Receiver's payment of IST's costs according to IST's normal 30-day payment terms, for the estimated costs set forth in the Motion, provided they fall within the thresholds described herein, in the ordinary course of the administration and operation of the receivership, as provided by Paragraph 56 of the Amended Receivership Order [ECF No. 141].

The Court finds that the Receiver has made a sufficient and proper showing in support of the relief requested. Accordingly, it is hereby

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Receiver's Motion to Approve Payment of Certain Electronic Discovery Costs in the Ordinary Course of the Administration and Operation of the Receivership [ECF No. 470] is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The Receiver is authorized to utilize IST to process electronic data and host it on a review platform, as further described in the Motion; and
2. The Receiver is authorized to pay IST's costs according to IST's normal 30-day payment terms, for the estimated costs set forth in the Motion, provided they fall within the thresholds described in the Motion, in the ordinary course of the administration and operation of the receivership, as provided by Paragraph 56 of the Amended Receivership Order.
