**ORDER GRANTING IN PART RECEIVER’S EXPEDITED MOTION TO SEAL**

Having reviewed the Motion and being otherwise duly advised, it is hereby

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Expedited Motion to Seal [ECF No. 807] is **GRANTED IN PART** as follows:

1. The Court hereby **SEALS** the **EXHIBITS** attached to the Motion *In Limine* [ECF No. 803], the **EXHIBITS** attached to the Motion for Partial Summary Judgment [ECF No. 804], and the **EXHIBITS** attached to the Statement of Facts [ECF No. 805] and instructs the Clerk to restrict public access to the aforementioned Exhibits.

2. Upon review of the Motions, the Court does not find that the Motion *In Limine*, the Motion for Partial Summary Judgment, and the Statement of Facts themselves contain confidential information under the terms of the Protective Order and therefore, these filings shall **NOT** be sealed.
