**PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR A FOUR-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME

Plaintiff respectfully requests an extension from February 21, 2022 to February 25, 2022 of the deadline set by the Court [DE 997] to submit a consent judgment with respect to the issues of disgorgement, prejudgment interest, and a civil penalty with respect to defendant Perry S. Abbonizio. The Commission has approved the settlement of these issues, and the consent judgment contemplates the delivery by Mr. Abbonizio of certain mortgages to the Commission. Those mortgages have been signed, but the originals have not yet been received by Mr. Abbonizio's counsel, who expects to have them early next week.

The motion is not sought for purposes of delay, and will not affect any trial date or other deadline in this case. Counsel for Mr. Abbonizio agrees with the relief sought herein.

WHEREFORE, the Commission requests that the Court enter the proposed order extending the deadline to submit the consent judgment with Mr. Abbonizio to February 25, 2022.
