# PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME TO FILE REPLY IN SUPPORT OF OMNIBUS MOTION FOR RELIEF AGAINST ALL REMAINING DEFENDANTS

Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission seeks an enlargement time until two days after entry of the Court's Order on the Plaintiff's Motion to Strike the Defendants' expert witness report that was filed with Defendants' Response to the Commission's Omnibus Motion for Relief and Final Judgments.

The Commission will file an omnibus Reply in support of its Omnibus Motion, addressing the responses filed by Defendants Michael Furman, Joseph LaForte, Lisa McElhone and Joseph Cole Barleta. If the Court grants the Commission's Motion to Strike, then the Commission would file its Omnibus Reply within two days of the date of that Order. If the Court denies the Motion to Strike, then within two days of the date of that Order the Commission would file a Motion for additional time based on the availability of the expert witness and defense counsel at that time to participate in discovery including the production of documents, expert witness disclosures, and a deposition.

This Motion is not filed for purposes of delay, but to ensure that the Commission's Reply brief addresses what is before the Court. If the expert report is before the Court, and thus the Motion to Strike is denied, the Commission will require time to conduct discovery concerning that report filed July 11, 2022.

WHEREFORE, the Commission respectfully requests an Order granting the Commission an enlargement of time until two days after the Court enters its Order on the Motion to Strike, to file the Omnibus Reply if the Motion to Strike is granted or to file a Motion for additional time in order to conduct discovery if the Motion to Strike is denied.
