### RECEIVER'S MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT MOTION TO (1) APPROVE PROPOSED PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION AND (2) AUTHORIZE FIRST INTERIM DISTRIBUTION TO ALLOW CLAIM FROM VICTORY INCOME FUND LLC

Ryan K. Stumphauzer, Esq., Court-Appointed Receiver ("Receiver") of the Receivership Entities, by and through his undersigned counsel, files this Motion to supplement his Motion to

(1) Approve Proposed Plan of Distribution and (2) Authorize First Interim Distribution [ECF No. 2014] (the "Distribution Motion") to allow a claim from Victory Income Fund, LLC ("Victory Income Fund"), and states:

#### I. <u>Introduction</u>

On August 23, 2024, the Receiver filed the Distribution Motion. Through the subsequent process of reconciling claims and preparing for a potential distribution, the Receiver received an inquiry from Victory Income Fund about why it does not have an Allowed Claim and proposed first interim distribution in the Receiver's proposed plan of distribution in the Distribution Motion. Prior to these discussions, the Receiver had no record of Victory Income Fund having filed a Proof of Claim as part of the claims process in this case. Through further discussion and investigation, the Receiver has confirmed that Victory Income Fund, in fact, filled out a Proof of Claim form and attempted to submit it to the Receiver's claims agent, but the Proof of Claim form was lost in the mail. Under the circumstances, as described more fully below, the Receiver believes it would be appropriate to allow Victory Income Fund's claim and to amend his proposed plan of distribution to provide for a distribution to Victory Income Fund.

#### II. Factual Background

On December 21, 2022, the Receiver filed a Motion to Establish and Approve: (1) Proof of Claim Form; (2) Claims Bar Date and Notice Procedures; and (3) Procedure to Administer and Determine Claims [ECF No. 1467] (the "Claims Procedures Motion"). The Court entered an Order granting the Claims Procedures Motion on December 23, 2022, establishing the procedures through which any person or entity who believes he, she, or it may have a claim against any

LLC; and ALB Management, LLC; and the receivership also includes the property located at 107 Quayside Dr., Jupiter FL 33477.

Receivership Entity was to submit a claim [ECF No. 1471] (the "Order on Claims Procedures Motion"). Pursuant to these procedures, a claimant was required to submit a Proof of Claim form to the Receiver's Claims Agent, Epiq Corporate Restructuring, LLC (the "Claims Agent"), on or before March 22, 2023 (the "Claims Bar Date"). [Order on Claims Motion at 2].

The Claims Agent received seven (7) Proofs of Claim from individual investors in the Victory Income Fund. The Receiver recommended that each of these claims be rejected on the basis that the claimants were investors in an agent fund that was not a Receivership Entity and, therefore, the claimants could not pursue a direct claim against CBSG. *See* Receiver's Motion to (1) Approve Proposed Treatment of Claims and (2) for Determination of Ponzi Scheme [ECF No. 1843] ("Claims Treatment Motion") at 13. The Court agreed with the Receiver's proposed treatment of these individual investors' claims. *See* Order on Claims Treatment Motion [ECF No. 1976] at 30.

Surprisingly, the Claims Agent did not receive a Proof of Claim form from Victory Income Fund. During his recent discussions with counsel for Victory Income Fund, the Receiver has determined that Victory Income Fund did, in fact, prepare and attempt to submit a Proof of Claim form on its own behalf. Attached as **Exhibit 1** is a copy of the Proof of Claim form that Victory Income Fund filled out and attempted to submit to the Claims Agent in March 2023 (the "Victory Claim Form").

Included with the Victory Claim Form is a copy of the Domestic Return Receipt card from the United States Postal Service ("USPS") that Victory Income Fund used to mail the Victory Claim Form to the Claims Agent. When the Receiver entered this tracking number on the USPS website, it appears that the package with the Victory Claim Form was lost in the mail. Specifically, the tracking information indicates that a return receipt number was associated with the package on

March 22, 2023 (*i.e.*, the Claims Bar Date)<sup>2</sup> and the latest update associated with this package was from April 2, 2023, indicating the following status:

Your item arrived at our USPS facility in PHILADELPHIA PA DISTRIBUTION

CENTER on April 2, 2023 at 5:25 pm. The item is currently in transit to the destination.

A printout of the USPS Tracking information is attached as **Exhibit 2**. Although more than 19 months have passed, the Claims Agent has not received the Victory Claim Form, and the USPS has not provided any additional status updates for this tracking number.

Thus, given that the agent fund manager completed and attempted to submit the Victory Claim Form, but it was lost in the mail through no fault of Victory Income Fund, the Receiver proposes that Victory Income Fund's claim be characterized as an "Allowed Claim," and it should be included in the Receiver's proposed first interim distribution.

According to the Victory Claim Form, the fund submitted a claim in the amount of \$942,000.00. When this claim is adjusted to account for Victory Income Fund's net investment amount, as the Court has determined is appropriate for calculating allowed claim amounts (*see* ECF No. 1976 at 26), the Allowed Claim Amount for Victory Income Fund's claim is calculated to be \$630,500.34. Because the inclusion of this claim would result in an additional Allowed Claim against CBSG, the calculation of the proposed first interim distribution amounts for all

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Notwithstanding this date whereby the tracking number was associated with Victory Income Fund's package with its claim form, the agent fund manager for Victory Income Fund appears to have signed the Victory Claim Form on March 26, 2023, and there is a stamp on the Domestic Return Receipt with a date of March 27, 2023. (*See* Exh. 1). Thus, it is unclear whether the agent fund manager dropped off the Victory Claim Form with the USPS on March 22, 2023, March 27, 2023, or some other date. Nevertheless, it is clear that the Victory Claim Form was at a USPS distribution center and intended for delivery to the Receiver's Claims Agent as of no later than April 2, 2023. When the Receiver provided his proposed recommendations for the treatment of claims, he factored in a short grace period and recommended allowing all otherwise valid claims that were submitted in late March or early April 2023. Thus, any potential discrepancy involving the postmark date for the Victory Claim Form has no impact on the Receiver's recommendation to treat Victory Income Fund's claim as an Allowed Claim and to allocate a distribution to this fund as part of the Receiver's first interim distribution.

Claimants with Allowed Claims would need to be adjusted if the total amount for distribution were to remain the same and the Victory Income Fund claim were simply added to the list of Allowed Claims.

As part of his proposed first interim distribution, the Receiver proposed holding back funds to address, among other things, unresolved, unknown, and other pending claims against the Receivership Entities. To avoid reducing the amounts the Receiver has already proposed distributing to other claimants, the Receiver suggests that this proposed holdback amount could be reduced by an amount that is equal to the amount Victory Income Fund would be entitled to receive, based on the same pro rata distribution amount that other claimants with Allowed Claims against CBSG would receive under the Receiver's proposed first interim distribution.

In the Receiver's proposed first interim distribution, Claimants with Allowed Claims against CBSG are scheduled to receive approximately 50.7% of their Allowed Claim amounts. Thus, using this same percentage, Victory Income Fund would receive the following first interim distribution:

<u>Claimant</u>	Allowed Claim Amount	First Interim Distribution
Victory Income Fund	\$630,500.34	\$319,883.01

Including this additional distribution amount would result in a reduction of the proposed holdback amount from \$60,173,155.69 to \$59,853,272.68. This slight reduction would be appropriate because the Receiver has recovered additional funds since the time he filed the Distribution Motion and proposed the holdback amount. For example, in the Receiver's Quarterly Status Report dated July 31, 2024, the Receiver reported a current cash balance, as of July 26, 2024, of \$166,295,148. [ECF No. 2005 at 2]. In the Receiver's most recent Quarterly Status

Report, the Receiver reported a current cash balance, as of October 31, 2024, of \$175,152,705. [ECF No. 2059 at 2].

In other words, the additional funds the Receiver has recovered over the past three months more than account for the reduction to the holdback the Receiver is proposing through this motion. Attached as **Exhibit 3** is an updated proposed schedule of the distribution amounts to all Claimants under the Receiver's proposed First Distribution, including Victory Income Fund. Attached as **Exhibit 4** is an updated proposed schedule of the distribution amounts to claimants with Allowed Claims against CBSG, including Victory Income Fund. If the Court agrees with the Receiver in allowing Victory Income Fund's claim and allowing it to participate in the first interim distribution, these exhibits could be substituted in place of the exhibits the Receiver previously submitted to the Court with his proposed Order on the Distribution Motion as Exhibits 1 and 2, respectively.

#### III. Analysis

The Court has broad discretion in establishing the claims and distribution procedures in a receivership. *See SEC v. Equitybuild, Inc.*, 18-CV-5587, 2023 WL 2018906, at \*1 (N.D. III. Feb. 15, 2023) ("District courts have broad discretion in approving a plan for distribution of receivership funds."). Included within that discretion is the authority to approve a proposed plan that allows late-filed claims where the claimants have provided a justification for their delay in submitting claims. *See Callahan v. Moneta Capital Corp.*, 415 F.3d 114, 120 (1st Cir. 2005) ("[A] District Court acting as a receivership court has broad discretion in determining whether to permit a claimant to file a late claim or to amend a timely filed claim."); *SEC v. Nadel*, 8:09-CV-87-T-26TBM, 2013 WL 12161449, at \*3 (M.D. Fla. Apr. 12, 2013) (noting that receiver allowed "late-filed claims in which the claimants provided reasons for missing the claims" as part of plan of

distribution). When evaluating a request to allow a late-filed claim, the Court applies an "excusable neglect" standard, which takes into consideration "the excuse offered by the party seeking the waiver or extension and the consequences to all persons affected by the granting or denying of it." *Commodity Futures Trading Com'n v. Lake Shore Asset Mgmt. Ltd.*, 646 F.3d 401, 405 (7th Cir. 2011).

Here, it appears that Victory Income Fund in fact prepared a Proof of Claim form and attempted to submit it to the Claims Agent. The Receiver and his Claims Agent did not receive Victory Income Fund's claim form. Through his investigation, the Receiver has discovered that the USPS tracking information reflects that the Victory Claim Form was lost in transit while in the possession of the USPS and, therefore, was never delivered to the Claims Agent. Thus, the Receiver believes inclusion of Victory Income Fund's claim at this late stage is appropriate. Moreover, at this late stage of the claims process, the Receiver is not aware of any other potential claimants with circumstances that are similar to those of Victory Income Fund. Specifically, this is the only agent fund for which the Receiver did not receive a Proof of Claim form, and the only agent fund that questioned its exclusion from the Receiver's proposed first interim distribution.

As a result, the inclusion of Victory Income Fund's claim would not serve as an invitation for other claimants who did not file timely claims to seek similar relief. Additionally, to the extent another claimant seeks to have a late-filed claim allowed in the receivership claims process, the Receiver would analyze the individual circumstances surrounding the late submission of any such additional claim. In other words, the Receiver's proposed recommendation about whether the Court should permit a different late-filed claim would be unaffected by, and untethered to, the Receiver's proposed allowance of Victory Income Fund's claim.

Finally, given that there have not yet been any distributions in this receivership, the timing of the Receiver's proposed inclusion of Victory Income Fund's claim will not delay or otherwise disrupt the initial distribution in this case. *See Lake Shore Asset Mgmt. Ltd.*, 646 F.3d at 405 (noting as factors supporting allowance of late-filed claim that the claim would have been accepted if timely filed and no distributions had occurred yet). And, the Receiver has proposed that the holdback he previously recommended as part of the Distribution Motion be reduced to account for the amount of the Receiver's proposed first interim distribution on Victory Income Fund's claim. As a result, the proposed distribution amounts to all other claimants will be unaffected by allowing Victory Income Fund to participate in the first interim distribution, as proposed in this motion.

#### V. Conclusion

WHEREFORE, the Receiver requests that the Court consider this amendment to his Distribution Motion, as set forth herein, and approve Victory Income Fund's claim with an Allowed Claim Amount of \$630,500.34 and a first interim distribution on Victory Income Fund's allowed claim in the amount of \$319,883.01.

Counsel for Victory Income Fund agrees with the relief requested herein. The Receiver recommends that other claimants be afforded one week to file a response to this motion. The Receiver would then file a reply, if necessary, within three days thereafter, and recommends that the Court's ruling on the proposed treatment of these claims be incorporated into the Court's overall Order on the Distribution Motion. A proposed Order establishing a briefing schedule on this motion is attached as **Exhibit 5**.


